

# OATH Camp 2010

## ***Boy Scout and Webelos Scout Joint Adventure***

April 30, 2010 through May 2, 2010

### **Who can attend?**

Any Boy Scout with their troop, current 4<sup>th</sup> grade Webelos Scouts and current Bear Cub Scouts (currently in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade as of May 2010) with their parents. Use this event as a recruiting tool for both the Cub Scouts and Boy Scout level! Your pack can be 'buddied up' with a troop if your unit needs help with equipment and camping skills.

**Where:** **Morrison-Rockwood State Park** (Where Cub Scout Day Camp is)

**Cost:** \$10 per Bear Cub Scout or Webelos Scout (current 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade scouts)  
\$5 per Boy Scout if Camping  
Parents/Adults/Scouters/Staff - \$5.00 if Camping (includes patch and cracker barrel)  
Staff NOT Camping - free  
Fee includes patch, program supplies and camping fees.

### **Registrations due by Friday, April 16, 2010**

### **Events will include:**

- Map & Compass Belt Loop
- Leave No Trace for the Cub Scout Level
- Knots for the Scout
- Campfire Preparation/Skits, Songs, etc.
- Flag Etiquette and Citizenship Badge
- Cooking – demonstrating the different kinds of outdoor cooking

Many of the events will apply to the BSA 2010 A Century of Making a Difference Award for the Scouts.

### **TROOPS or CREWS –**

Troops and Crews are needed to STAFF the events. This will include providing Boy Scouts to run the event with adult supervision, materials and supplies for the events. Do not assume reimbursement without verifying with the camp planning committee. Some funds are put aside for supplies, but not much.

**Schedule:** (more detailed schedule to be mailed to units upon registration and distributed at camp upon check in)

Friday - 6:00 PM to 8:30 PM    Check In and Set Up                      Quiet Time by 10:00 PM  
(no meals or snacks provided by camp – all food provided by units/participants)

Saturday:            Check In and Set Up: 7:00 – 8:00 AM (if late arrival)  
Opening Flag Ceremony at 8:45; sessions begin at 9:00 AM. Lunch break at Noon (**units provide ALL their own food**). Sessions resume at 1:30 and conclude approximately at 4:30. Closing campfire beings at dusk. Cracker Barrel for ALL following the campfire with food provided by the participants.

Sunday Morning, check out by 10:00 AM. Pick up medical forms for your unit and patches, if available at that time.

Regarding advancements – it will be up to the individual pack committee if advancements earned at this event can apply to the current Bear, soon to be Webelos Scouts advancement record.

# OATH Camp 2010 Checklist

- Select a coordinator for your pack, troop or crew. This person will be responsible for all information packets and must also attend the event or have a 'designated leader' in their place.
- Announce the event to all Bear dens and 4<sup>th</sup> grade Webelos Scouts as soon as possible.
- Get commitments from parents who will attend with their boys. An acceptable boy to adult ratio should be followed. For Boy Scouts, usual 'camporee' or district event guidelines apply.
- Collect registration fees and medical forms for all boys and adults attending OATH Camp. One person from your unit will show the medical forms upon check in at the camp and will be responsible for them at all times during the event. Medical Forms part A and C are to be completed and brought to camp.

- Complete one registration form per pack, troop or crew. Write ONE check per pack payable to Blackhawk Area Council. Bring to camp a separate roster for scouts, adults and staff, including youth staff.
- Mail completed registration form and approximate head count with a check to Carol Conderman postmarked no later than April 16, 2010. NO REFUNDS. If numbers increase upon check-in, be sure to bring check or cash for the additional payment.
- NOTE: No participant will be allowed to attend without a medical form turned in at time of check in. This INCLUDES adults. Current medical forms can be found on the Blackhawk Area Council web site at : <http://www.blackhawkscouting.org/forms/medical/index.html>
- It is STRONGLY recommended that someone in attendance with the pack has attended BALOO training.
- Two Deep Leadership policies will be followed. EACH unit, whether pack, troop or crew, must have in attendance at least TWO adults that have taken Youth Protection in the last two years. This is available online at [www.scouting.org](http://www.scouting.org).
- Units will be supplying their own meals, please plan accordingly. Above Ground Fires Only! Please bring a fire bowl or be prepared to share the grills and fire pits at the camp sites.
- Once unit registration is in, a packet will be mailed to the coordinator detailing what to bring, what to expect, etc., especially for the packs.
- Saturday Cracker Barrel after the campfire is for all in attendance, please bring food to share.
